Gentlemen:

Attached please find two prints of Carlton H. Ettlenger Survey # 62364 indicating the ownership of Glenvic, Inc. The limits of ownership have been outlined in blue. Glenvic is desirous of creating a new car sales facility, to be known as Motorama, at this location. Tentative plans call for the establishment of six different new car agencies plus a car wash, bank and auto diagnostic center within the property. The combination of modern facilities, additional space for each agency and massive group advertising should result in total car sales of over 300 per week. The potential income to the City and State, based on an average selling price of \$4000 should approach \$9,000 per week. This type of planning is the means by which the present economic plight of both the City and State will be resolved. Business is presently lost to Reedman Motors in the State of Pennsylvania. The loss of this business and income can no longer be afforded. The taxes must be added to local and state coffers. The job opportunities both construction and sales, must be kept in order to combat the bleak unemployment situation. The project must go ahead.

It can be noted that a small portion of the property is below elevation 10 in the datum based on 0.0 equals Richmond High Water. In order to develop this property in its entirety it would be necessary to bring the lower areas to the adjacent legal grades which vary from elevation 7 to elevation 11. There is no tidal action touching this property. To the best of my knowledge, based upon visual inspection, there are no fresh water wetlands involved. The survey indicates a ditch or watercourse in the southeast corner of the property.

Until four years ago, this ditch conveyed local storm water to the tidal area. At that time the City of New York constructed twin 16 foot wide storm sewers in South Avenue and intercepted the upland flow. The ditch now conveys only local rainfall from the property in question.

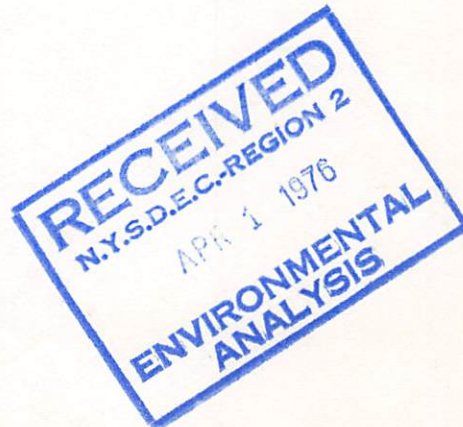
It is requested that a "D" letter be issued authorizing the filling of this property to legal grade. Adjacent properties may be wetlands. It is possible that work within the owners property may affect the adjacent properties. My client is most anxious to develop his ownership and would be agreeable to abiding by similar restrictions to those imposed in the Trebor/Zoe Street application. Such items as construction fence or berm to contain run-off from the property could be arranged.

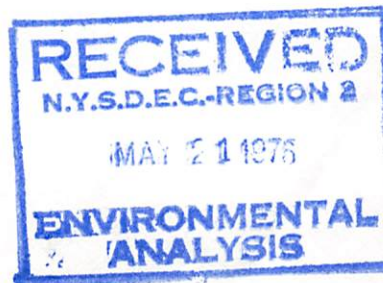

In our discussion as to method of delineating that area which may not be filled without a hearing, you had recommended field location of the fragmides as the best indication. Two copies of Carlton H. Ettlenger Survey No. 62364 are attached for your review. Please note that the inward encroachment of the fragmides has been indicated on the maps together with boundary, at all times clear of the fragmides, in which no fill operation may take place. Notes to this effect have been placed upon the survey.

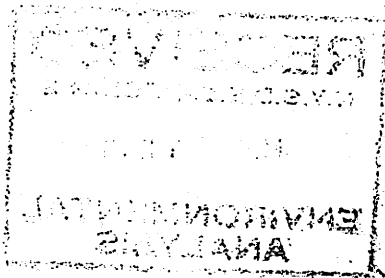

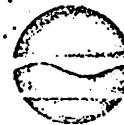

As a result of your inquiry dated March 16, 1976, a field inspection was made to determine if the above parcel is subject to regulation by this Department in accordance with Article 24 (Freshwater Wetlands) of the Environmental Conservation Law.

It has been determined that the subject parcel is not a freshwater wetland as defined in Article 24. Therefore, no freshwater wetlands interim permit will be required for any activity conducted thereon.

However, please be advised that part or all of the tax lots listed in this designation request are tentatively classified as tidal wetlands or adjacent areas subject to final adoption pursuant to Article 25 (Tidal Wetlands Act) of the Environmental Conservation Law. Therefore, a Tidal Wetlands Moratorium Permit will be required pursuant to 6NYCRR, Part 660 (the Rules and Regulations for the Tidal Wetlands Moratorium Period) for any alteration of these lands.

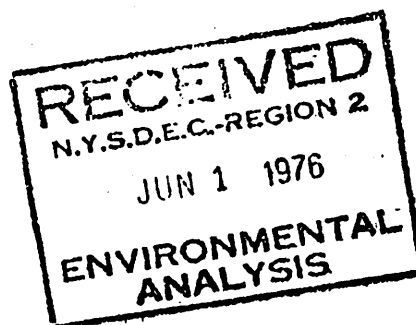
